C. Explanation

- 1. God has more power than He actually exercises.
- 2. God can and does do whatever is in His will and counsel (Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:27; Matthew 19:26).
- 3. There are some things which God cannot do.
 - a) He cannot violate His characteristics.
 - b) Be contradictory

D. Points of application

- 1. He has made this power available (Acts 1:8; Ephesians 1:19).
- 2. He provides His power to accomplish His will (Philippians 4:13).
- 3. No one can defeat or overpower Him (Acts 5:38-39; Romans 8:38-39).
- 4. He is able to fulfill promises (Romans 4:21).
